City of Belleville Committee of Adjustment Thursday, March 21, 2024 at 3:30 P.M.

The Committee of Adjustment Meeting will be conducted in-person in Council Chambers at City Hall.

A Public Meeting, as noted above, will be held on March 21, 2024 at 3:30 P.M. to consider an application under Section 45 of the Planning Act submitted by Three Hills Engineering on behalf of Meave Phillips.

This application proposes an expansion to a non-conforming single detached dwelling that would increase the height of the roof from the existing height of approximately 21.5 feet (6.6 m) to approximately 23 feet (7.0 m). The applicant further wishes to construct a second floor above the existing rear addition that would be cantilevered approximately 1.21m to the north from the existing rear addition, and to modify the roof line at the rear with proper eaves that will extend closer to the south property line.

A location map is shown on APPENDIX1, attached.

As per the requirements of the Planning Act, this application is confirmed to be complete.
