City of Belleville Committee of Adjustment

Thursday, August 19th, 2021 at 3:30 P.M.

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 situation, the City of Belleville is now conducting all committee meetings virtually. Members of the public will still have the ability to provide input and watch meeting proceedings digitally.

A Public Meeting, as noted above, will be held on August 19, 2021 at 3:30 P.M. to consider an application under Section 53 of the Planning Act submitted by Spencer Hutchison of RFA Planning Consultant Inc. on behalf of Williams Hotels (2013) Ltd.

The subject property is municipally known as 400 Bell Boulevard, and is zoned CH-28/MS – Highway Commercial and Special Industrial Zone in By-Law 2076-80. The application proposes to sever the existing hotel development from the remaining undeveloped land behind, creating one (1) new commercial lot. The severed lot will have a lot frontage of 60 metres on Bell Boulevard and a lot area of 0.7 hectares. The retained lot will remain accessible through an easement from Bell Boulevard and have a lot area of 2.3 hectares. A 0.3 metre reserve is proposed to prevent development of the retained lot until such time as access and servicing requirements are addressed to the satisfaction of the municipality will be accessible through about 30 metre wide and 90 metre long easement, and have a lot area of 2.3 hectares.

A Location Plan is shown on APPENDIX 1, attached.

As per the requirements of the Planning Act, this application is confirmed to be complete. The lands subject to this application are not subject to any other type of planning application.

Those who have registered will be provided with the Zoom meeting information prior to the meeting date. Registration will close at 4 p.m. Tuesday, August 17, 2021.

How to ask a question during the meeting:

Registered members of the public will be able to provide comments and ask questions during virtual public meetings in a similar manner as in-person public meetings. The Chair of the meeting will announce each registered member when it is their turn to speak. Each registered member will be allocated five (5) minutes to provide comments and/or questions regarding the application.

Any person may attend this meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to this application using methods explained above, or you may be represented by counsel for that purpose.

How to be notified of the decision:

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the City of Belleville Committee of Adjustment in respect of this application, you must submit a **written** request by emailing planning@belleville.ca or in writing to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Committee of Adjustment by mail at: Belleville City Hall, 169 Front Street, Belleville, K8N 2Y8.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the City of Belleville Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent does not make a written submission to the City of Belleville Committee of Adjustment before it gives or refuses to give a provisional consent, the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.

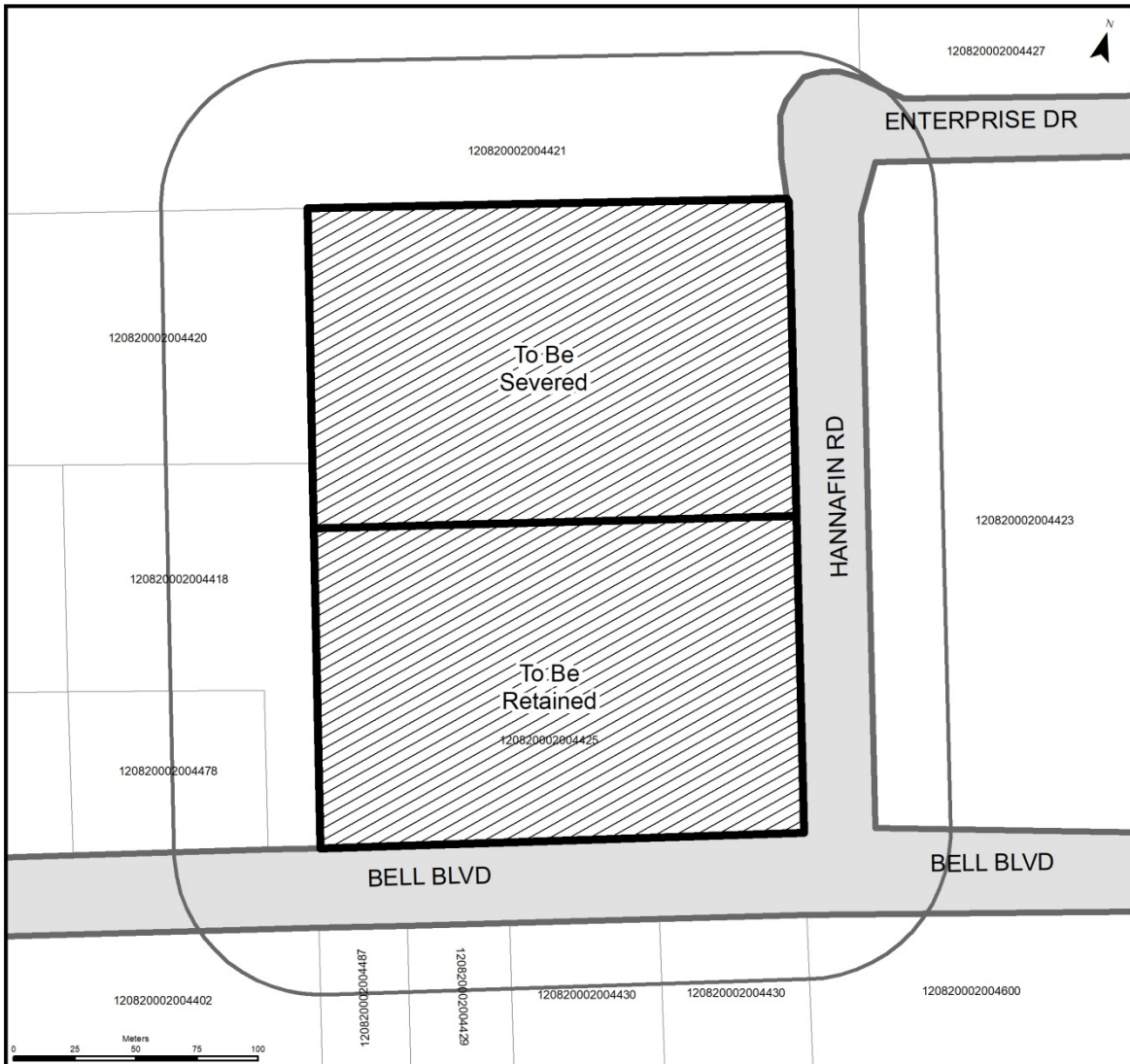
