

Pre-consultation for Smaller Applications

Smaller applications include only one of the following types of approvals:

- Consents
- Minor variances
- Re-zoning of single residential property

Before submitting development applications, applicants are to pre-consult with Planning Staff, by appointment, to ensure that both the applicant and the Municipality have a clear understanding of the purpose of the proposed application.

Purpose of the Meeting

The purpose of the pre-consultation meeting is to identify the information and materials required prior to processing a complete application as set out in the Planning Act. Preconsultation does not imply or suggest any decision on the part of City Staff or the City of Belleville to either support or refuse the application. While we make every effort to ensure that the information is complete and accurate, there may be items of clarification required or other supporting information that is discovered during the review process. The City of Belleville reserves the right to correct, modify and/or add to the information and materials as the process moves forward.

In order to be considered a complete pre-consultation meeting request, the following are required prior to a meeting being scheduled:

- 1. Completed Pre-Consultation Meeting Form (as attached);
- 2. Drawings/plans showing the proposal which should include the general location of existing and proposed buildings, structures and features.

Drawings/plans are to be provided in paper and digital form. Digital copies (in PDF format) can be emailed to planning@belleville.ca.

The supporting information and materials specified in the pre-consultation will be required to be submitted with the planning application(s) in order to be considered a "complete application" under the Planning Act.

Important: This form will be reviewed by the Policy Planning Department at the preconsultation meeting and will form part of a complete application. The applicant acknowledges that the application and any attached supporting documentation is



collected and maintained specifically for the purpose of creating a record available to the general public. The applicant is responsible to notify the City of Belleville on any errors, omissions, or changes in the information contained below after the completion of the pre-consultation form. Personal information on this form is collected under the authority of the Municipal Act, as amended, and the Planning Act, as amended, and will be used for the purposes of processing this form.
